



Top 5 Topics Submitted to *Consultant* Reflect Its Multidisciplinary Mission

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Last month, we wrote about why clinicians, researchers, and other health care professionals should consider **submitting their work to *Consultant***. At its core, *Consultant* is a home for practical, peer-reviewed clinical education across the full spectrum of patient care. Since 1961, the journal has remained committed to helping clinicians translate clinical knowledge, evidence, and real-world experience into better patient care.

This month, our submission trends offer a timely reminder of why that broad, multidisciplinary mission matters. Based on author-selected classifications, the 5 most frequently submitted topic areas to *Consultant* in 2026 so far are:

- **Dermatological disorders**
- **Pediatrics**
- **Primary care**
- **Cancer**
- **Infectious diseases**

These trends reinforce what we emphasized last month: *Consultant* is not bound to a single specialty, disease state, or content format. The top submission categories in 2026 offer a snapshot of authors' interests and a view into where clinicians see opportunity, uncertainty, and educational need.

Whether authors are sharing a complex case, summarizing emerging research, offering a clinical perspective, or highlighting lessons from practice, their work can help bring practical knowledge into patient care across specialties.

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
